How Your Gift Helps Hospice

Your support enables Whatcom Hospice to provide end-of-life services and therapies above and beyond those covered by Medicare and private insurance. Thanks to your generosity, our patients and their families have access to a 24/7 Board-Certified Hospice and Palliative Care Medical Director, home respite care, pain and symptom-relieving complementary therapies, education, Hospice House, and bereavement support. And because of you, we never have to turn a patient away if they cannot afford to pay for hospice care. *Thank you!*

AREA OF NEED		WHAT IT PROVIDES
Medical Director	\$100,000	Round-the-clock access to Medical Directors who are board-certified in hospice and palliative medicine.
In-Home Respite	\$15,000	Up to 60 hours of in-home respite care for each patient receiving hospice care in their own home, allowing their caregivers a short break.
Hospice House Room and Board Assistance	\$175,000	Five days of covered room and board at Hospice House to assist each new family in acclimating to the facility and to help relieve their financial burden.
Uncompensated Care	\$75,000	Assistance with uninsured costs of end-of-life services for patients who do not qualify for Medicare or Medicaid and have no other payer. Also, assistance for those unable to afford their insurance deductibles and copays.
Palliative Treatments	\$75,000	Assistance with uninsured cost for palliative treatments needed for symptom control and quality of life.
Complementary Therapies	\$100,000	Access to alternative therapies like acupuncture and massage for medication-free management of troubling symptoms like anxiety, nausea and constipation, which are common at the end of life.
Patient & Family Education	\$5,000	Customized education packets for each hospice family containing detailed instructions about how to care for their dying loved one.
Patient & Family Assistance	\$5,000	Immediate discretionary funding for special patient and family needs identified by hospice staff.
Bereavement	\$15,000	Bereavement education and support including support groups, grief packets, "Grief Talk" mailings, "We Honor Veterans Program" and more.
Staff Development	\$30,000	Education and training for our growing hospice team.
Volunteer Development	\$3,000	Training and support programs for caring volunteers who are available to help families with tasks like grocery shopping, cleaning and medication delivery.
Community Education	\$2,000	Hospice and advance care planning materials, education and outreach.

Total FY18 Program Grant: \$600,000.00*

*Whatcom Hospice Foundation also covers facility maintenance for Whatcom Hospice House and Hospice Administration Building and property. In Fiscal Year 2018 over \$69,132 was allocated for maintenance.

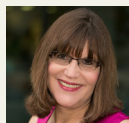

To recognize the generosity of those who partner with us in extraordinary ways, Whatcom Hospice Foundation has created a giving society with four levels:

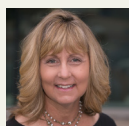
- Cornerstone Club—Lifetime giving of \$100,000 or more

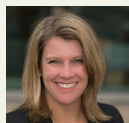
