How Your Gift Helps Hospice

Your support enables Whatcom Hospice to provide end-of-life services and therapies above and beyond those covered by Medicare and private insurance. *Thank you for making a difference!*

AREA OF NEED	GRANT	WHAT IT PROVIDES
Hospice House Room and Board Assistance	\$200,000	Five days of covered room and board at Hospice House to assist each new family in acclimating to the facility and to help relieve their financial burden.
Complementary Therapies	\$160,000	Access to alternative therapies like acupuncture and massage for management of troubling symptoms like anxiety, nausea and constipation, which are common at the end of life.
In-Home Respite	\$75,000	Up to 60 hours of in-home respite care for each patient receiving hospice care in their own home, allowing their caregivers a short break.
Uncompensated Care	\$75,000	Assistance with uninsured costs of end-of-life services for patients who do not qualify for Medicare or Medicaid and have no other payer. Also, assistance for those unable to afford their insurance deductibles and copays.
Palliative Treatments	\$75,000	Assistance with uninsured cost for palliative treatments needed for symptom control and quality of life.
Security Support	\$67,500	After-hours security for the hospice campus and Whatcom Hospice House.
Community Liason	\$50,000	A staff member to work with referring providers and other key community stakeholders to ensure seamless, coordinated patient care and a positive experience with our services.
Administration Building Renovation	\$35,000	Renovation to facilitate improved efficiency of Hospice work teams.
Staff Development	\$30,000	Education and training for our growing hospice team. Assistance with costs of attaining hospice and palliative care certifications.
Bereavement Program	\$20,000	Bereavement education and support including support groups, grief packets, "Grief Talk" mailings, "We Honor Veterans Program" and more.
Hospice House Cook	\$20,000	A part-time cook for Whatcom Hospice House patients.
Patient & Family Education	\$10,000	Customized education packets for each hospice family containing detailed instructions about how to care for their dying loved one.
Patient & Family Assistance	\$10,000	Immediate discretionary funding for special patient and family needs identified by hospice staff.
Community Education	\$7,500	Hospice and advance care planning materials, education and outreach.
Volunteer Development	\$3,500	Training and support programs for caring volunteers who are available to help families with tasks like grocery shopping, cleaning and medication delivery.
Total FY19 Program Grant: \$838,500.00*		

*Whatcom Hospice Foundation also covers facility maintenance for Whatcom Hospice House and Hospice Administration Building and property. In Fiscal Year 2019 over \$75,295 was allocated for facility and property maintenance.

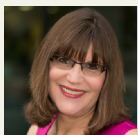
To recognize the generosity of those who partner with us in extraordinary ways, Whatcom Hospice Foundation has created a giving society with four levels:

- Legacy Society—Planned gift or estate gift

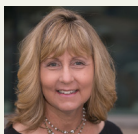
Member Benefits

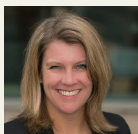
